Proposed extinguishment of Public Footpath No. 20 Appleton

This Council has received a request to stop up a section of the above footpath off Dipping Brook Avenue in the above parish following the granting of planning permission for residential development. The path to be stopped up will be replaced with an alternative public footpath constructed to adoption standards following the estate footways and link footpaths adjacent to a public open space to the north west of the existing route.

I enclose a map indicating the section of footpath to be stopped up by a bold black line and the proposed alternative by a broken black line between points A and B. I also enclose a relevant extract of the definitive map and a map showing the confirmed estate layout.

I am satisfied that it is necessary to stop up the footpath to enable the development to take place and that, once constructed, the new footpath will serve as a suitable alternative to the definitive one.
